



Crystal Gayle

To become Official Opry Member



Grammy-winning songstress Crystal Gayle was surprised during her Grand Ole Opry performance by Opry member Carrie Underwood with an invitation to become an official Opry member. Gayle will be formally inducted into the Opry on Jan. 21, 2017 by her sister, Opry legend Loretta Lynn. Gayle made her Opry debut nearly 50 years ago on the Ryman Auditorium stage, singing the country classic "Ribbon of Darkness" at age 16.

About Crystal Gayle:

Crystal Gayle made her Opry debut when she performed in place of her Opry member sister Loretta Lynn who had been too ill make her scheduled appearance. To escape musical comparison to her hit-making sister, Gayle developed her own vocal and musical style. She had 20 No. 1 country singles, beginning with "I'll Get Over You" and including her signature song, "Don't It Make My Brown Eyes Blue." That song earned her a Grammy for Best Female Country Vocal Performance and also made her album *We Must Believe In Magic* the first by a female country artist to go Platinum.

She was awarded CMA Female Vocalist of the Year in 1977 and 1978, and the Academy of Country Music honored her with the same award in 1976, 1977 and 1979. Her chart successes include "Cry," "Talking In Your Sleep," "Why Have Left The One You Left Me For," "Half The Way," her duet with Eddie Rabbitt, "You And I," and many more. In 2008, Gayle was inducted into the Kentucky Music Hall of Fame, and in 2009 she received a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame.

Country Radio Seminar will be held Wednesday, February 22 through Friday, February 24 at the luxurious Omni Nashville, in the heart of downtown Nashville.

About Country Radio Seminar:

Country Radio Seminar is an annual convention designed to educate and promote the exchange of ideas and business practices in the Country music industry, with specific emphasis on issues relevant to Country radio. CRS 2017 will be held Feb. 22-24, 2017.

Toby Keith will appear as a featured speaker at Country Radio Seminar 2017. Sponsored by BMI, Toby Keith: My Way at CRS 2017 will take place Friday, Feb. 24 from 3:00-4:00 pm.

The discussion will explore Keith's career, what inspired him to take control of his recorded and live music, form his own label and build a business empire on his terms. Keith will also talk about his strong relationship with men and women of the military, and his dedication to charitable initiatives. Leading the discussion will be RJ Curtis and Beverlee Branigan.

The appearance marks Keith's return to the seminar since being recognized with CRB's Artist Humanitarian Award in 2007; the same year he was the headline artist on Country Radio Seminar's Music City Jam.


