

Blue Mafia Band • Hanging Tree www.bluemafiaband.com





The event, titled 1 Night. 1 Place. 1 Time: A Heroes and Friends Tribute to Randy Travis, will also feature performances from Alabama, Kenny Rogers, Rodney Atkins, Chris Janson, Jamey Johnson, Montgomery Gentry, Michael Ray, Ricky Skaggs, Michael W. Smith, The Randy Travis Band, Tanya Tucker, Josh Turner with more still to be announced. Tickets for the highly anticipated event are on sale now at all Ticketmaster locations and the Bridgestone Arena Box Office.



In October, Randy Travis was officially inducted into The Country Music Hall of Fame. The multi-platinum country giant suffered a massive stroke in 2013 and has made miraculous strides towards recovery since, recently singing "Amazing Grace" at his Country Music Hall of Fame induction ceremony as well as the tagline to his iconic "Forever and Ever, Amen"



at the 2016 CMA Awards in November alongside numerous country legends and stars.



A portion of the proceeds will go to the Randy Travis Foundation; a 501(c) 3 non-profit that raises money for stroke research and

rehabilitation.

"Nashville is coming together on February 8 for one night in one place and at one time to give back to their friend and musical hero, Randy Travis. It's amazing to see the support that Randy has received from the music industry since his stroke. We're thrilled to have all of these artists come out and pay tribute to him," said producer of the event and Travis' manager, Tony Conway of Conway Entertainment Group.

Larry Stewart **Speaks Out**

Larry Stewart, lead singer of legendary country group Restless Heart spoke out following his performance at the presidential inauguration in Washington D.C.

"It was such an honor to be asked to represent our country and to be a part of that historic event," says Stewart. "The concert celebrating the incoming president was the largest crowd I've performed for in my career. We were told there were nearly a million people. Amazing!"

Stewart along with Lonestar's Richie McDonald and Tim Rushlow, formerly of Little Texas, collectively known as the Frontmen of Country, represented Nashville as they performed at the Make America Great Again

Stewart continues, "Performing those Restless Heart hits on so many major national news networks in America was absolutely incredible. However, there were a few news stories implying I was no longer the lead singer of Restless Heart. That's not true. I'm still with the band doing almost 100 concerts a year."

The five original members of Restless Heart, John Dittrich, Dave Innis, Paul

Gregg, Greg Jennings, and Stewart, are entering their 34th year on the road.




2017 Class of New Faces of Country Music Show Announced


